THE SPIRIT OF NEW YORK CRUISE INFORMATION

Attire. What is the dress code on the Cruise?

For evening cruises, appropriate attire is business casual to dressy. Men traditionally wear slacks and sport coats, with or without ties. Women wear dresses or nice pants. T-shirts, jeans, shorts or sneakers are not permitted.

Boarding. What is "Boarding Time" and "Cruising Time?"

"Boarding Time" is the earliest guests may board the ship. Typically boarding begins 1/2 hour prior to the "Cruise Time." Tickets may be picked up at the dockside kiosk up-to one hour prior to the cruise.

Children. Are there any age requirements?

Children are welcome on almost all cruises.

Coast Guard Regulations. Is the vessel Coast Guard certified?

Yes. The ship is Coast Guard certified and maintained regularly to adhere to strict safety regulations.

Cruise Route. Where does the ship go?

The ship cruises the Hudson and East Rivers past the skyscrapers of Manhattan including the Empire State Building. You will see the Intrepid Sea-Air Space Museum, the Brooklyn Bridge, the site of the World Trade Center, Battery Park City, South Street Seaport, the Verrazano Narrows Bridge, Governor's Island, Ellis Island and the Colgate Clock. Of course, the highlight of the cruise is the Statue of Liberty, one of the most celebrated landmarks in the world.

Dancing. What kind of dance music is played?

Lunch and dinner cruises feature a full range of popular dance tunes spun by some of the city's hottest DJs. Selections may include Rock, Blues, Line Dances, Motown, Oldies, Salsa, Hip Hop, Country, and current chart-toppers from every musical genre.

Directions. How do I get to the ship?

The ship departs from Chelsea Piers.

Drinks. What do drinks cost?

Mixed drinks start at \$9, beer starts at \$8, and wine begins at \$7.50 per glass. Soft drinks are \$2.50 each. Coffee, tea and iced tea are included in the ticket price. All other beverages can be purchased on board. Prices do not include tax or gratuity and are subject to change.

Entertainment. What type of entertainment is offered?

The harmonic notes of a Baby Grand Piano greet guests, followed by the sophisticated sounds of an acoustic trio and the satin-smooth melodies of our talented vocalist over dinner. After dessert, the sounds of soft jazz, Broadway and blues entice dancing and romance surrounded by the greatest entertainment of all – a 180-degree view of the greatest skyline in the world.

Gratuity. Is gratuity included in the ticket price?

A service charge is included in the price and covers gratuity on the food portion of the ticket price. It does not include any gratuity for beverages purchased on the ship or for any outstanding personal service provided by your server.

Groups. What size group can the ship accommodate?

Parking. Is there parking close to the ship?

Yes, There is ample paid parking available just steps away from the ship at Chelsea Piers. It is a covered lot with security. Prices vary depending on the amount of time you are parked.

Seasickness. Will I get seasick?

It's unlikely. The ship operates in New York Harbor, on the Hudson River and the East River, which are all very calm bodies of water. What's more, the ship is large and very stable, so in most cases, you can hardly tell that its moving.

Seating. How is seating arranged on board?

The ship is very flexible when it comes to seating. Tables for two, four, six, eight and even more can be arranged to suit almost every party and occasion.

Ship Information. Can you tell me a little about the ship?

The all glass ceiling and wall, 300-passenger Bateaux New York is Manhattan's most luxurious dinner cruise ship. Spaciously designed with climate-controlled interior decks, two outdoor strolling decks and a spacious hardwood dance floor.

Smoking. What is the smoking policy?

All interior areas of the ship are non-smoking areas. Passengers who smoke may do so on the outdoor observation decks.

Tickets. Where can I pick up the cruise tickets?

Tickets can be conveniently picked up at the dock up to one hour prior to the cruise. Photo ID will be required.

Weather. Does the ship sail in inclement weather?

Absolutely. Ships are fully enclosed and climate-controlled for your comfort. Cruises sail rain or shine year round.



DIRECTIONS

FROM WESTCHESTER:

- Take Saw Mill Parkway south to West Side Highway.
- Continue south to 23rd Street.
- Bear right at the Chelsea Piers signs and proceed to Pier 61, Chelsea Piers.

FROM LONG ISLAND:

- Take Long Island Expressway to Midtown Tunnel.
- Out of tunnel, go left for two blocks to 34th Street.
- Go right on 34th to 11th Avenue.
- Turn left on 11th Avenue and continue to 24th Street.
- Turn right and proceed for one block.
- Turn left onto the West Side Highway and continue for one block.
- Bear right at the Chelsea Piers sign and proceed toward Pier 61, Chelsea Piers.

FROM THE HOLLAND TUNNEL:

- Take Holland Tunnel to West Side Highway North.
- From the West Side Highway bear right onto 11th Ave and continue for two blocks.
- Turn left onto 24th street and continue for one block.
- Turn left onto the West Side Highway and proceed for one block.
- Bear right at the Chelsea Piers sign and proceed toward Pier 61.

FROM THE LINCOLN TUNNEL:

- When exiting the tunnel, follow signs to West Side Highway South.
- Continue south to 23rd Street.
- Bear right at the Chelsea Piers sign and proceed to Pier 61, Chelsea Piers.

VIA BUS:

- Take north/south route to 23rd Street.
- Take the #23 bus west to Chelsea Piers (last stop) and walk to Pier 61.

VIA SUBWAY:

- Take C, E, 1, or 9 to 23rd Street.
- Take the #23 bus west to Chelsea Piers (last stop) and walk to Pier 61.
