SAN DIEGO CRUISE INFORMATION

What is the dress attire for the cruises?

Lunch, Brunch or Moonlight Cruises: We recommend business casual attire, such as khaki pants and collared shirts. No jeans, shorts or tank tops will be allowed. Dinner Cruises: Business casual attire is requested. No jeans, shorts or tank tops will be allowed.

What time do I board the ship?

Boarding time is 30 minutes prior to departure for all cruises

Where is the best place to park?

The following parking lots, which are available on a first come, first served basis:
San Francisco: Pier 33 has a small lot, \$10 per car (\$20 on holidays)
Pier 3 has a large lot, \$10 per car

Is gratuity included?

Generally gratuity is included.

What happens if it rains or snows?

The ship sails rain or shine. In the case of severe weather conditions or upon the direction of the U.S. Coast Guard, the ship will remain dockside.

What kind of entertainment is on board?

The ship offers inviting dance floors and a variety of music - from the dance hits of the 40's through today as well as a variety of jazz, standards and popular favorites.

Is smoking allowed?

Smoking is allowed on the outside decks only.

Are there vegetarian options available?

Yes, vegetarian meals are available and can be arranged at the time of booking. If you have a group with many vegetarians or if you have vegans please notify a sales representative at the time of booking.

Are there any age restrictions on your cruises?

There are no age restrictions for any of our Lunch, Brunch, Dinner or Monte Carlo cruises.

Is the ship handicapped accessible?

Are life preservers on board?

Each vessel is 100% Coast Guard certified with life preservers and all required life saving equipment, including child life vests.

Is there a phone on the boat that receives calls?

Phones are not available for guests' use. Most cellular services are available on the water as we do not cruise beyond one mile off shore.

Can we meet the Captain and visit the bridge?

Yes. Guests are welcome to come and meet the captain and his first mate.

When is dinner served?

Dinner service begins immediately upon embarking.

Do we need to pre-select the menu before the day of cruising?

No, you do not need to pre-select your menu. We have a menu that you will chose from onboard.

Is there pre-assigned seating?

As you board, our captain and marine crew will direct you to your deck. From there the host/hostess will show your party to your assigned table (s). Seats are assigned based on needs and capacity for each cruise.

DIRECTIONS

WESTBOUND BAY BRIDGE:

- Take the Fremont Street exit (exits from the right-hand lane of the bridge).
- At the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Fremont Street. Turn right at the first light which is Howard Street.
- Continue to the end of Howard Street to The Embarcadero.
- Turn left onto The Embarcadero and continue to Pier 3.

NORTHBOUND 101:

- Take 1-80 towards the Bay Bridge. Take the Fourth Street exit.
- Make a right onto Fourth Street. Continue on Fourth Street to Townsend Street.
- Make a left onto Townsend Street. Continue to the end of Townsend Street to The Embarcadero.
- Turn left onto The Embarcadero and continue to Pier 3. Turn right into Pier 3.

SOUTHBOUND 101:

- Take Marina Blvd. to Bay Street.
- Turn left onto Bay Street. Continue to the end of Bay Street to The Embarcadero.
- Turn right onto The Embarcadero.
- Turn right on Washington and make a U-turn toward The Embarcadero.
- Turn left onto The Embarcadero.
- Turn right into Pier 3.

PARKING

PARKING LOT

Limited public parking is available at pier 3. \$10 per car.

METERED PARKING LOT

Limited public parking is available around this location (25¢ per half hour, free after 6:00 p.m.).

EMBARCADERO CENTER GARAGES

(Four Separate Facilities) During the weekdays, they charge \$2.75 every half-hour. Weekday Evenings (5:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m.) and weekends (10:a.m. to 3:00 a.m.) they charge \$2.50 for every hour.

GOLDEN GATEWAY GARAGE

(Entrance located on Clay Street across from Embarcadero Center #2) They charge a flat rate of \$2.50 per 30 minutes. Their hours are Monday – Thursday, 4 a.m. to midnight, Fridays 4 a.m. to 2 a.m., Saturdays 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. and Sundays 9 a.m. to 10 p.m.

PAID PARKING LOT

Parking located on Davis St. between Broadway St. and Vallejo St. \$12.00 weekdays from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and \$5.00 weekends and weekday evenings from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

PAID PARKING LOT

Parking located on the corner of Embarcadero St. and Broadway St. \$12.00 weekdays and \$5.00 weekends and weekday evenings from 4 p.m. to 5 a.m.

PAID PARKING LOT

Parking located on Embarcadero St. and Washington St. (directly across from Pier 3) \$5.00 per hour with a maximum daily charge of \$12.00. Their hours of operation are Monday through Sunday 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
