LOS ANGELES CRUISE INFORMATION

What is the dress attire for the cruises?

Lunch, Brunch or Moonlight Cruises: We recommend business casual attire, such as khaki pants and collared shirts. No jeans, shorts or tank tops will be allowed. Dinner Cruises: Business casual attire is requested. No jeans, shorts or tank tops will be allowed.

What time do I board the ship?

Boarding time is 30 minutes prior to departure for all cruises

Where is the best place to park?

Fisherman's Village Marina, Validation for 2 hours, \$.75 per hour thereafter.

Is gratuity included?

Generally gratuity is included.

What happens if it rains or snows?

The ship sails rain or shine. In the case of severe weather conditions or upon the direction of the U.S. Coast Guard, the ship will remain dockside.

What kind of entertainment is on board?

The ship offers inviting dance floors and a variety of music - from the dance hits of the 40's through today as well as a variety of jazz, standards and popular favorites.

Is smoking allowed?

Smoking is allowed on the outside decks only.

Are there vegetarian options available?

Yes, vegetarian meals are available and can be arranged at the time of booking. If you have a group with many vegetarians or if you have vegans please notify a sales representative at the time of booking.

Are there any age restrictions on your cruises?

There are no age restrictions for any of our Lunch, Brunch, Dinner or Monte Carlo cruises.

Is the ship handicapped accessible?

Are life preservers on board?

Each vessel is 100% Coast Guard certified with life preservers and all required life saving equipment, including child life vests.

Is there a phone on the boat that receives calls?

Phones are not available for guests' use. Most cellular services are available on the water as we do not cruise beyond one mile off shore.

Can we meet the Captain and visit the bridge?

Yes. Guests are welcome to come and meet the captain and his first mate.

When is dinner served?

Dinner service begins immediately upon embarking.

Do we need to pre-select the menu before the day of cruising?

No, you do not need to pre-select your menu. We have a menu that you will chose from onboard.

Is there pre-assigned seating?

As you board, our captain and marine crew will direct you to your deck. From there the host/hostess will show your party to your assigned table (s). Seats are assigned based on needs and capacity for each cruise.

DIRECTIONS

TO APPROACH FROM JAMBOREE ROAD

- Traveling North on Pacific Coast Hwy, drive approximately 2 miles. Look for Ardell's •
- Yacht & Ship Brokers on the left.
- Turn left into Hornblower Cruises & Events just after passing Ardell's. (If you get to the stoplight at Tustin, you have gone about 100 yards too far.)

TO APPROACH FROM NEWPORT BOULEVARD (ROUTE 55)

- Traveling West on Newport Blvd, just after the stoplight for Hospital
- Road, take the right-hand exit for Highway 1.
- At the bottom of the hill, make a left at the light for Pacific Coast Hwy.
- Pass stoplights at Riverside and Tustin.

Turn right into Hornblower Cruises & Events. (If you get to Ardell's, you have gone about 50 yards too far.)

Although it is possible to use Newport Boulevard to Pacific Coast Highway, alternate routes are highly recommended, especially in December.

TO APPROACH FROM THE SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (405)

- Take the Marina Fwy (90) going west
- Turn left onto Mindanao Way
- Turn left onto Admiralty Way
- Turn right onto Fiji Way
- Park in the lot marked Fisherman's Village

ON SITE PARKING OPTIONS

Parking is limited at the Newport Beach facility.

Monday-Friday Evenings, Saturdays, Sundays, Holidays – There is limited on-site parking available.

Monday - Friday 8:00am-6:00pm – There is no on-site parking available.

PARKING LOT

Price ranges from \$6.00 to \$10.00 per car depending on season.

METERED PARKING LOT

Limited public parking is available across the street in a metered City Parking Lot (25¢ per hour, up to 10 hours payable at one time).
